Welcome to Horseshoe Lake!

On behalf of the Horseshoe Lake Corporation (HLC) board, we would like to welcome you and your family to Horseshoe Lake! This new member packet is designed to familiarize you with your responsibilities as members of Horseshoe Lake. Please review the following information carefully, so that you can begin enjoying the lake as soon as possible.

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(A) BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The HLC Board of Directors is composed of seven members, serving 2-year terms. Board members are elected at the annual membership meeting.

(B) LAKE EVENTS

The Horseshoe Lake community works together to ensure our lake is well cared for, fun and safe for all our members. Several events throughout the year provide us with opportunities to come together as a community.

- April – Annual Membership Meeting
- May – Lake Clean-up & Member Picnic
- May/June – Dues Collection Days
- June – Carp Fishing Derby
- July – 4th of July Parade & Fireworks Show

(C) NEW MEMBER INFORMATION

1) **Provide us with your contact information.** If you have not done so already, please provide us with your contact information (names, emails, and phone numbers) by sending an email to horseshoelakecorp@gmail.com.

2) **Activate your membership.** In order to complete your registration with HLC, the following items must be provided to the board:

- a) Transfer Fee
- b) Warranty Deed
- c) HLC Subscription Agreement

These items may have been handled by the title company at closing. Once we have your contact information, our treasurer will contact you if we do not have the required items.

3) **Check your email!** Your information will be added to the membership list and to the member website. Email is our main way of communicating with members about safety issues, water status, lost & found, items for sale, lake events, etc. You can add multiple email addresses to our mailing list.

4) **Check out the member website.** Every household is given one login for the website. The website has all HLC documents you might need: rules and regulations, bylaws, shoreline improvement forms, insurance waivers, etc. We also have a classified section, lost and found, around the lake forum, upcoming events, and board meeting information.

5) **Set up your new member orientation.** You can arrange your orientation with any board member. We encourage you to do this as soon as possible, as you cannot use any motorized watercraft until the orientation has been completed.

(D) NEW MEMBER ORIENTATION

All new members are required to attend an orientation with a board member, designed to familiarize you with the lake. Orientations are typically done in the spring when the water level is sufficient for boating. The orientation will include a tour of the lake and a review of the rules & regulations. Members can contact any board member to set up the orientation. All household members of boating age are strongly encouraged to attend. Please read the HLC Rules & Regulations before your orientation.

(E) BOAT REGISTRATION FOR NEW MEMBERS

In order to use any motorized watercraft and vehicles (boats, jet skis, four wheelers, etc.) on Horseshoe Lake, new members must provide the following:

1) SIGNED ORIENTATION FORM

- All new members are required to complete a lake orientation with a board member before using watercraft on the lake. This is done by boat when the water level is sufficient for boating (usually in the spring).
- You can contact any board member to set up your orientation.

2) COMPLETED WAIVER/LIABILITY FORM (MUST BE COMPLETED ANNUALLY)

- This form serves as a liability waiver, insurance certification and agreement to the HLC rules and regulations.
- The form must be signed annually in the presence of a board member or notarized.
- By signing his form, you are also attesting that you, all members of your household, and all guests will abide by all the HLC rules and regulations. It is your responsibility to know the rules. We have never had a major accident on the lake, and work really hard to keep it that way. In order for the lake to be fun and safe for everyone, all members help to enforce the rules.

3) PROOF OF ZEBRA MUSSEL INSPECTION

- All motorized watercraft must have a zebra mussel inspection before being used on Horseshoe Lake.
- Zebra mussel inspections can be done at Boyd Lake State Park.
- Anytime your watercraft is used on another body of water, you **MUST** get a zebra mussel inspection before returning to Horseshoe Lake.

4) PROOF OF OWNERSHIP

- Proof of ownership is provided by a Colorado registration (also known as a CL #).
- Registration does not have to be current every year, but we require a one-time registration if the watercraft does not have a CL #.
- Boats and personal watercraft can be registered at the Boyd Lake State Park office.

5) PROOF OF INSURANCE

- A minimum of \$300,000 liability insurance must be issued by an insurance company licensed in the State of Colorado for all motorized watercraft and vehicles to be used on the lake or lakebed.

6) ANNUAL DUES & STICKERS

- Once all of the above documentation has been provided, and annual dues are paid in full, you can purchase the stickers for your motorized watercraft & vehicles (\$5 each).
- We have several dues payment/sticker days in the spring, or you can contact one of the treasurers.
